Directions:

- Take U6 to Naturkundemuseum(Berlin) stop. Head Southeast on Chausseestraße toward Invalidenstraße. Turn Right on Invalidenstraße, then turn Left on Luisenstraße. Enter the Charité on Luisenstraße 13 and pass through the building. Make a Right on Hufelandweg.
- Take S1, S2, S5, S7, S25, S75 Bahn or U6 to Friedrichstraße. Exit the station on the North towards Reichstagsufer and cross the Spree. Head on Albrechtstraße. Make a Left on Schumannstraße until you reach the Charité main entrance. Head on Virchowweg and make a slight Right on Hufelandweg.
